Submission Instructions

Papers submitted to IEEE Data S&P 2024 should be written in English conforming to the [IEEE Conference Proceedings Format](#) (8.5" x 11", Two-Column). The paper should be submitted through the EDAS (<https://edas.info/newPaper.php?c=32806>). The length of the papers should not exceed 6 pages + 2 pages for over length charges.

Accepted and presented papers will be included into the IEEE Conference Proceedings published by IEEE CS CPS and submitted to IEEE Xplore. Authors of accepted papers, or at least one of them, are requested to register and present their work at the conference, otherwise their papers will be removed from the digital libraries of IEEE CS after the conference. Distinguished papers presented at the conference, after further revision, will be recommended to special issues of reputable SCI/EI-indexed journals.

Submitting a paper to the workshop means that, if the paper is accepted, at least one author should attend the Symposium and present the paper.
